Social distancing not maintained by students before school starts	Parents asked to ensure pupils come straight into school. Staff with visibility will enforce social distancing on the school site.	Yes	Severity:4 Likelihood:1 Risk Rating:4
Social distancing not maintained in school corridors	No groups will come into contact with each other due to one way system. Markings on floor will indicate the 2 mt distance.	Yes	Severity:4 Likelihood:1 Risk Rating:4
Social distancing not maintained in classrooms	Class sizes are 5 or lower at present. All children in Dolphins and Seahorses are seated at a distance of 2 mts from each other. Only 1 child will be permitted to move for example to the toilet at any one time. The overall risk rating is a 12 which is medium risk. Turtles nursery and reception, are not expected to socially distance and so the risk here is increased. The overall risk rating is a 20 which is very high risk.
